RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE PROCUREMENT CONTRACEPTIVE (INJECTABLE) for CY 2020 REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, Open Competitive Bidding for the Procurement of Contraceptive (Injectable) for CY 2020 requirements was conducted in accordance with the Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184) and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;

WHEREAS, on **October 30, 2020**, the Invitation to Bid (IB) was posted in the PhilGEPS;

WHEREAS, a Pre-bidding Conference was held on **November 06, 2020 at 9:00 am** at DOH-CHD-CAR Office Regional Training Center, BGHMC Compound, Baguio City where ten (10) prospective bidders attended, namely:

WHEREAS, Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 2020-001 dated **November 9, 2020**, was issued to modify or amend the technical specifications;

WHEREAS, the Submission and Opening of Bids took place as scheduled on **November 18, 2020 at 9:00 am** at the Regional Training Center, Department of the Health-Center for Health Development-Cordillera Administrative Region (DOH-CHD-CAR) Office, BGHMC Compound, Baguio City;

WHEREAS, two (2) prospective bidders procured the bidding documents and submitted their respective proposal, namely:

1. SGS Healthcare Co.
2. Steritex Medical System

WHEREAS, the first envelopes containing the Eligibility and Technical Documents were opened. The presence, completeness and correctness of the required documents were checked and verified by the designated Bids and Awards Committee (BAC). Upon checking, Steritex Medical System was declared “NOT ELIGIBLE” and was rated “FAILED” because there was no Bid Security submitted, instead a Performance Securing Declaration was submitted. While, SGS Healthcare Co. was declared “ELIGIBLE” and was rated “PASSED”;

WHEREAS, the second envelope containing the Financial Proposal was opened. The presence, completeness and correctness of the required documents were checked and verified by the BAC. Upon checking, SGS Healthcare Co. was declared “ELIGIBLE”, was rated “PASSED” and subsequently the bid proposal was read publicly and written in the Abstract of Bids, to wit:

A request for reconsideration was received last **November 18, 2020** from Steritex Medical System. A reply letter dated **November 23, 2020** was sent to them denying their request.

WHEREAS, letter dated **November 20, 2020** was sent to the Lowest Calculated Bidder (LCB), SGS Healthcare Co., requesting to submit post qualification requirements;

WHEREAS, on **November 24, 2020**, SGS Healthcare Co. submitted their respective additional documentary requirements as part of their technical requirements;

WHEREAS, on **November 26 – December 01, 2020**, detailed evaluation of the submitted proposal on the Legal, Technical and Financial aspects of documents on the Lowest Calculated Bidder (LCB) for the above item was undertaken by the designated Technical Working Group (TWG);

WHEREAS, on **December 04, 2020**, the TWG submitted their Bid Evaluation and Post Qualification Reports citing specific findings on the submitted documents/clarifications by the LCB for the item;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) certifies that there is “no pending incident” as regard to the result of the post qualification evaluation for this particular project;

NOW THEREFORE, on the basis of the above, the herein members of the BAC HEREBY RESOLVE, to award the item listed below to the following bidder that was determined to have the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB):


